The State of Workplace Disability Inclusion & Digital Accessibility: 2020

UKG[™] surveyed 1,000 managers at U.S. companies with more than 150 employees to understand whether leaders are well-equipped to effectively support direct reports with disabilities, especially as the pandemic has driven more companies to adapt

to remote work. Among the findings, responses indicated that when things return to normal in the office, more than three quarters of employees think their companies' accommodation of employees with disabilities or employees requiring reasonable accommodations will be better, compared with times before COVID-19.
