In his senior year, JJ was awarded The Villages' Miata Car MX-5 Club scholarship to continue his automotive education. JJ is currently enrolled in the Automotive Collision Technology Technician program at Lake Technical College, which is designed to prepare students for employment in the automotive collision repair and refinishing field.
